## Tired of Unwanted Phone Calls? Solution: *The National Do Not Call Registry*

The National Do Not Call Registry gives you an opportunity to limit the telemarketing calls you receive. Once you register it will take up to 90 days to become effective, and the registered telephone number(s) will remain on the list for five years from the date first published on the list. The national registry is nationwide in scope, applies to all telemarketers, with the exception of certain non-profit organizations. Companies that you have a business relationship (i.e. your bank and credit card companies) are not restricted by the Do Not Call registry.
