RETURNING COLLEGE STUDENT APPLICATION FORM

Objective

The objective of the Roosevelt County Rural Telephone Education Foundation Scholarship fund is to assist those individuals who desire to further their education and who desire to acquire the knowledge and skills to be better prepared to participate in the future employment marketplace. It is intended that the RCRTC scholarships encourage individuals to demonstrate civic responsibility and scholastic achievement.

Applicants must be a returning college student and be a legal dependent of an active member, whose permanent residence is within the service area or be the active member whose permanent residence is within the service area.

Qualification Criteria

The applicant must be an active member of Roosevelt County Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc., or immediate family of an active member (son, daughter, legal ward) as of January 1 of the current year and who has had at least two months' phone service. To qualify, the account must be in good standing.

AN ACTIVE MEMBER IS DEFINED AS A RCRTC CUSTOMER RECEIVING A TELEPHONE LANDLINE TO THEIR HOME OR BUSINESS FROM A RCRTC EXCHANGE (253, 273, 274, 276, 477, 478, 482, OR 675).

Amount and Disbursement of Scholarship

The scholarship awarded by the Roosevelt County Rural Telephone Education Foundation is a one-year scholarship and the amount and number of scholarships awarded is determined by the basis of funds. Once the Education Foundation receives proof of full-time enrollment, the scholarship will be made available prior to the beginning of the fall semester.

The recipient is responsible for having verification and proof of enrollment of their intent to attend the college/university/ trade school in the RCRTC office two (2) weeks before the beginning of the school term. No monies will be issued without this verification, or after December 15th of the year awarded.

Type and Location of School

The scholarship can be used for any educational institution of higher learning specifically concentrating on undergraduate work. This will include any junior college, college, university, trade or vocational school. The student may attend school in any state of the United States.

Scholarship Application (see reverse side)

The complete application must be delivered or post marked to the corporate headquarters of Roosevelt County Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. dba Yucca Telecom, 201 West 2nd Street, Portales, New Mexico 88130 by **March 2**. Late applications will not be accepted. The complete application MUST include:

- Official Transcript
- Resume (include education, activities, community service, special achievements and work history)
- Completed application form and required signature
- A one-page essay that answers how this scholarship will aid you in your educational goals
- Recommendation letter signed from a civic or religious leader, employer or family friend (in a sealed envelope)
- Recommendation letter signed from a school official at the school you currently attend (in a sealed envelope)
